DBD46 'WELCOME' pattern- \$10

Easy to make & soooo cute!

Perfect size to hang over your door!

Interesting tabs make this a show stopper!

Just fuse fabric pieces onto a black fabric background!

Add some of those embellishments you are collecting....

buttons, beads, glitter, angelina fibers....

12" x 41-1/2"

'WELCOME' kit- \$39

Just cut apart and fuse to the backs of your fabrics!

From Wendy: Are you concerned with values or do you just not care?
The Queen answers: "Wendy! As Queen I should be offended by your question but I am sure you are asking about the values of fabrics I use. giggle
Values are key when it comes to choosing fabrics. Make sure every quilt you make, whether it be small or large, has fabrics that are light, medium & dark. Our natural tendency is to choose medium fabrics. Go look at your fabric stash... it probably contains about 90% mediums. Keep that in mind so when you are shopping for fabric, force yourself to stock up on some light & dark fabrics and your next quilt will be sure to sing!!"

I know quilters sometimes have an aversion to cooking but it can be easy & fun!! Cooking is my hobby so I just had to share one of my very bestest favorite crockpot recipes. I took this to a potluck & there was so little left in the crockpot that someone must have stuck their head in it and licked it clean!

Crockpot Potato Soup

4 cups cubed potatoes (peeled or unpeeled)

Put into crockpot

1 onion, chopped

1 cup celery, chopped

3 T. butter

Saute onion & celery in butter & add to crockpot

Add: 2 cups or so of cubed ham...whatever you have
leftover up to 2 cups

Mix in a bowl & pour into crockpot:

3/4 cup sour cream

3 cups chicken broth

1 cup water

1 can of cream of chicken soup

1 Tbl. fine herbs

2 tsp. pepper

Stir & cook on high for 5 hours or low for 10 hours...

just until the potatoes are tender. Yummy!
