By the way, this recipe was copied down by my Grandma Bertha years ago when she listened to a show called Party Line on KATE radio in Albert Lea, MN.

AWARD WINNING SLOPPY JOES!

BROWN: 1 pound of hamburger
1/2 cup onion, chopped
1/2 of a green pepper, chopped (our update on this classic)

Add: 1 Tablespoon brown sugar
2 Tablespoons apple cider vinegar
1/2 teaspoon mustard
3/4 cup catsup

Let it all simmer for 20 minutes.

Optional, if needed: 1 Tbls. flour to thicken (sometimes it needs it but I have lean hamburger & don't need to add it)

You can easily double, or triple this recipe.
